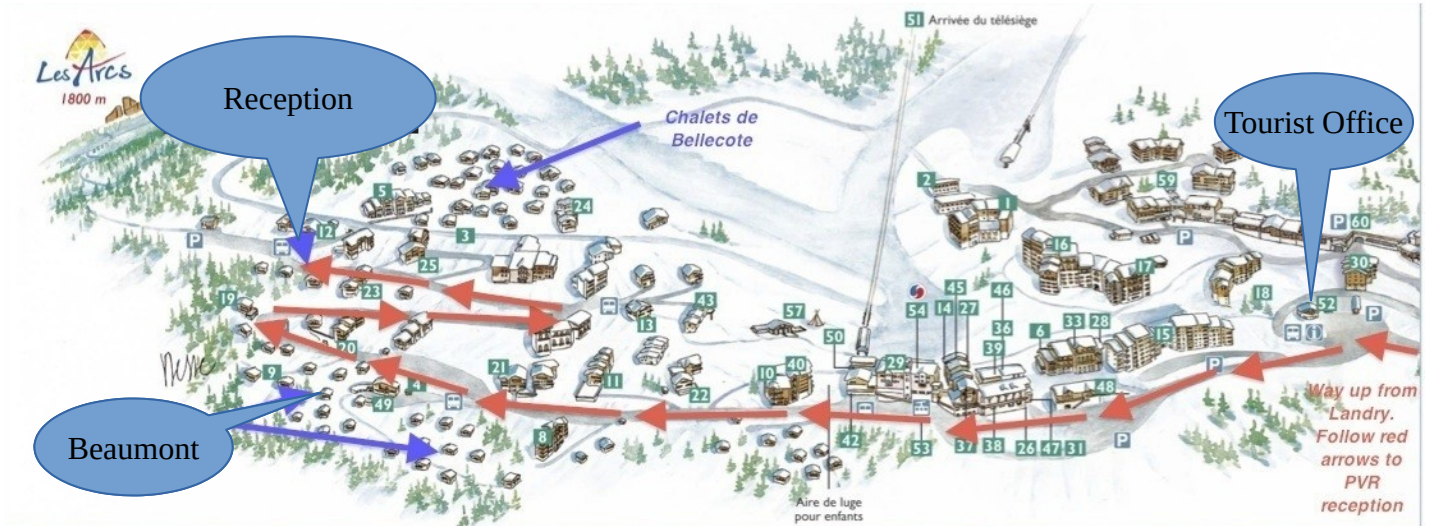


**Dear Guests,**

Thank you for confirming your booking of our chalet in Vallandry. Now for some pre-arrival details ...



**ARRIVAL:** First of all you need to drive up to the reception .... Below is a map of the Village showing how to get to the chalet and to our *Alpine Essence* Reception - very easy as it is a "one street village".



Our management team is really really good. Please can you let them know in advance (contact details below) the approximate time of your arrival, which should ideally be late afternoon (officially 17:00 but can often be earlier).

*Top tip: if you are early, stop off at the Leclerc in Aime, do your shopping and then go for a drink in the really cool micro brewery bar opposite.*

Pippa will give you the key code for the chalet, sort your bread and croissants' delivery if you want it, tourist tax (approx 1.87 euros per person over the age of 18 per night), and the refundable security payment (card swipe). She will direct you to the chalet. If you would like to rent a garage for your bikes, there is a garage just opposite the chalet that they can rent out (subject to availability) on your behalf for approx. 50 Euros a week but be sure to book in advance.

To get to the chalet, drive down to the front of the big Dahu chalet for off-loading. Then park just above.

**Important** – If you plan to arrive later than 20:00 you must telephone *Alpine Essence* reception on **+33 (0) 750 66 52 81** or +33 771 64 03 94 to make arrangements - but don't worry as there is a key safe on the chalet and they will give you the code.



If you are staying in the chalet '**out of season**' do not forget to stop off in Aime (Casino/Leclerc) or Bourg (SuperU) to shop before coming up the mountain. And don't forget that they are shut on Sunday afternoons. Your nearest shop to the chalet out of season is the Sherpa ([Tel : +33 \(0\)479079296](tel:+330479079296)) in Peisey Village, the village below Vallandry, (shuts 12.30 - 15.00) + a Boulangerie next to it (go in the morning).

**If you are driving** you should allow 10 hours travel to/from Calais + breaks and about 280 euros each way for tolls, plus the fuel of course. We always stay in the Hotel Bal in Tournhem just off the motorway 20 minutes outside of Calais. It's very peaceful, cheap (Booking.com), the rooms are good and if you ring them to warn them that you will be late, they will tell you your room number and leave the key in the room. Troyes is a good stop if you want about 4 hours after Calais (Hotel du Cirque has good parking and is dog friendly - or - for self catering BonAppart 2 - Charme Napoléonien & Confort).

#### **Airport Transfers from Geneva, Lyon, Grenoble or Chambéry -**

- Generally people coming in summer fly either to Lyon or Geneva. If you are flying you are probably best off renting a car for a week as airport transfer charges and trains are silly money. [Information and Pricing](#) – really expensive! [Jays Taxis](#) – very slightly less expensive or [Edelweiss Taxis](#) – we use them.
- If you fly to Chambéry (not many flights in summer) and want to take the train you will need to take a taxi from the airport to the train station – there is no local bus (captive audience!).
- The train does stop at Landry in the ski season but check carefully the summer timetable. [Train Transfers](#) from Bourg St Maurice or Landry.

#### **DEPARTURE:**

We ask you to vacate the chalet before 10am - the cleaners are very prompt! You will also need to arrange for reception to inspect the chalet before you leave (Fri evening) in order to guarantee a full refund of your security payment - don't forget!

#### **Answer to a FAQ:**

Mobile phone signals are strong all over the mountains and there is fibre broadband internet in the chalet. UK Freesat TV & Orange are available in the chalet along with a DVD, your laptop will plug in directly (VGA or HDMI) as the screen is a standard computer monitor.

We do hope you enjoy your stay in our chalet - please feel free to send us any feedback you have so that we can fix problems as they arise and improve our service for next season. We also invite you to fill in the Visitors' Book, leaving any top tips that you would like to pass on.
